Supporting Staff Safety

All staff will be orientated to the District's [*Safe and Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan*](#) and the schools' Communicable Disease Prevention Plan on Tuesday, September 7th.

All staff K-12 are required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools, and on school buses.

All staff K-12 will complete a Daily Health Check prior to attending school.

The plan to maintain personal spacing between staff in staff only spaces is:

- We will continue to follow the room maximums as per the guidelines set out by Worksafe.

Communication to Parents/Guardians

This Communicable Disease Prevention Plan will be communicated to parents and guardians by September 7th, 2021. This includes posting a copy of the plan on the school's website.

Information on Daily Health Check for parents to complete at home with their child will be emailed to parents prior to September 7th, 2021.

New students and families will be provided with health screening information when registering.

Supporting Student Safety

All students will be orientated to the appropriate sections of the District's *Safe and Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan* and the schools' Communicable Disease Prevention Plan on Tuesday, September 7th.

All students, grades 4 to 12 are required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools, and on school buses.

Students, grades K to 3, are strongly encouraged to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools, and on school buses. However, there are no requirements for mask wearing for students in grades K to 3.

Students who need a non-medical mask can come to the office to get a disposable mask. Students will be expected to bring a reusable mask to school each day.

The plan to ensure personal spacing of students, including considerations for entering and exiting the school, moving from classroom to classroom and to and from common spaces is:

- Students will stay to the right in hallways to avoid congestion. All entrance/exit doors will be open to ensure that there is not congestion while moving into and out of the school. Lockers will be assigned to individual students (no sharing) and students will not be allowed to congregate at lockers.

Lockers

The plan for student locker use is:

- Individual students will be assigned lockers and must have a lock in order to use a locker.
- No congregation of students will be allowed in the hallways around lockers. Students may be at their lockers for the sole purpose of exchanging books for classes and getting items from their locker.

Visitors

All visitors are required to complete a Daily Health Check prior to entering the school.

All visitors are required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools.

To further support student and staff safety, the procedure for visitors will be:

- Visitors will call the office for an appointment.
- Upon entering the building, visitors will sign in and check the declaration that they have done a Health Check and do not have symptoms of Covid 19.

All volunteers are required to participate in training prior to working with students and staff in schools.

The process for this training will be:

- Volunteers will have to go through the safety orientation with administration before entering classroom spaces.

Student Transportation on Buses

How will students line up for buses to ensure personal spacing?

Before school:

- Students will maintain personal space while waiting for the bus.

After school:

- Students will maintain personal space outside while waiting for the bus.

Considerations for inclement weather:

- During inclement weather days, students may stay inside the school and spread out to ensure that they are maintaining personal space.

Food Services/Lunch

The plan for delivery of food services or lunch is:

- Lunch will be served at the cafeteria from behind a Plexiglas screen.
- Students will line up in an orderly fashion maintaining personal space.
